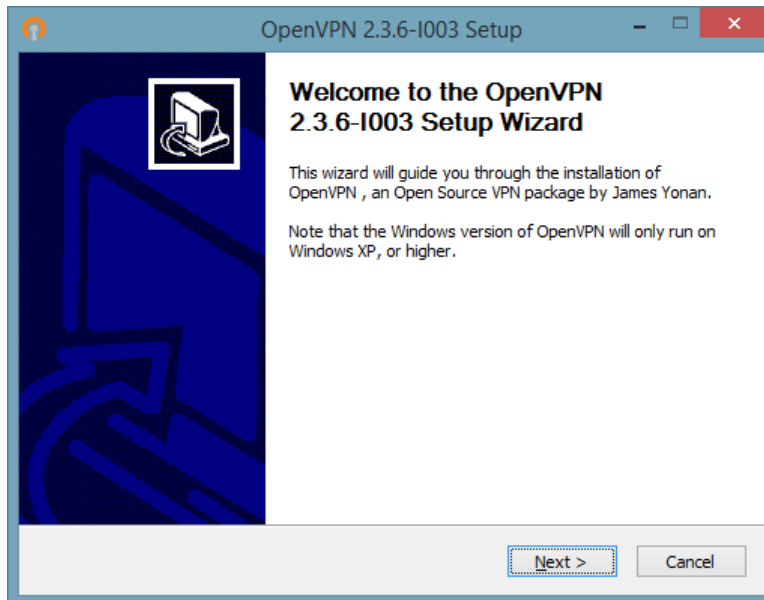


OpenVPN Setup instructions

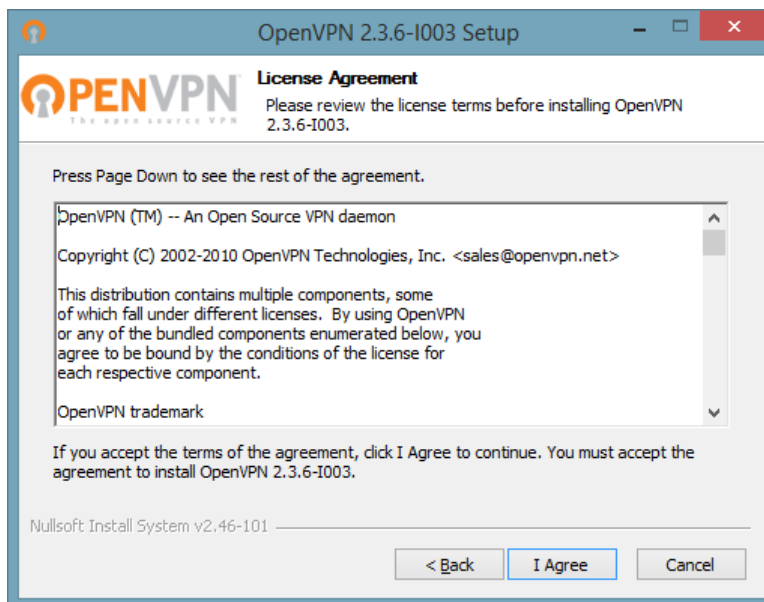
If you want to set up OpenVPN on Windows 7, you have to install it's GUI. You can [download it for free from here](#).

After you've downloaded the software install it:

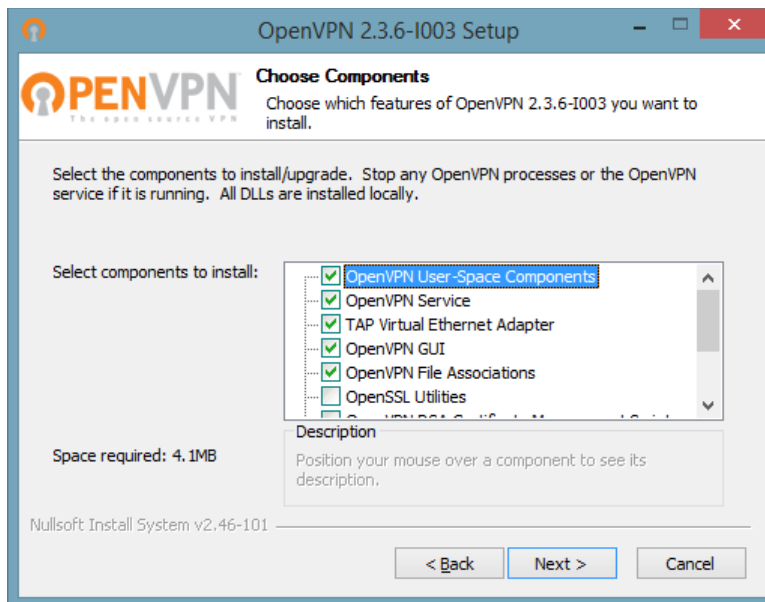
1. Click the "Next" button.



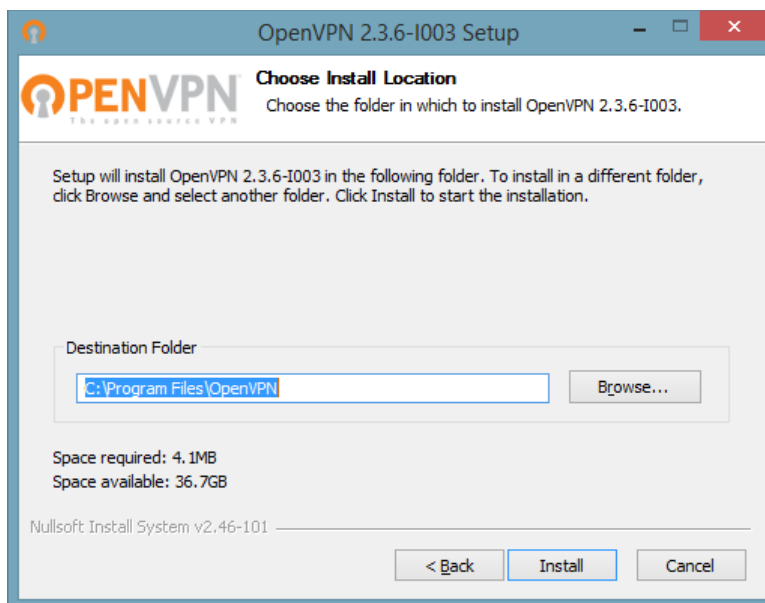
2. To continue click the "I Agree" button.



3. Click the "Next" button.



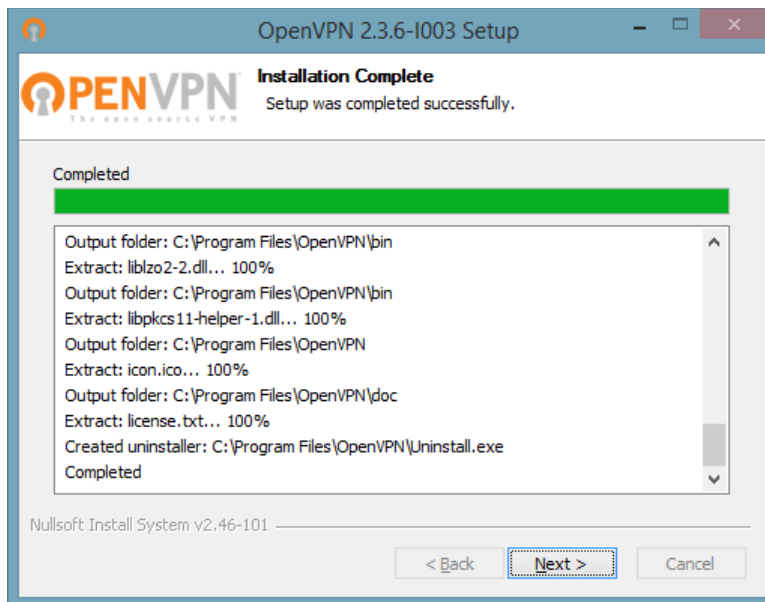
4. Click the “Install” button.



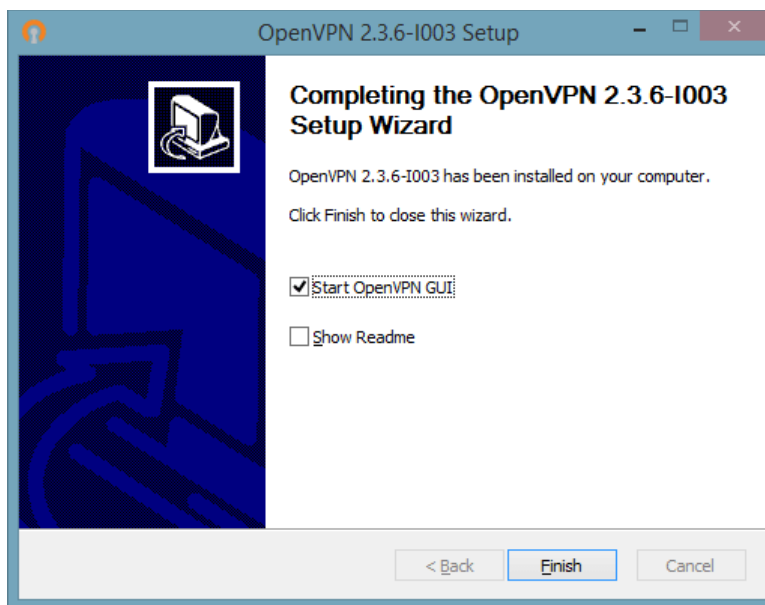
5. If you have the following message, press “Install”.



6. Click the “Next” button.



7. Click the “Finish” button like is shown in the following screenshot.



8. Now you need to download the config files according to your package and unzip the downloaded file.

Copy all the files to OpenVPN config folder. Normally you’ll find it on following path: *C:\Program Files\OpenVPN\config*. Copy config file into the “*C:\Program Files\OpenVPN\config* folder”.

If you receive an error about privileges, then move zip archive to *C:* folder, extract and move back to *C:\Program Files\OpenVPN\config* folder.

9. Now, in the toolbar, you should see a symbol for OpenVPN. Right click on the symbol with the mouse, choose the server you want to connect and click “Connect”. You can select between two different protocols for OpenVPN: TCP and UDP. UDP is usually faster so we recommend to try it first.

To disconnect, just right click on the OpenVPN server you where connected and select Disconnect.
